Hello,

The Fall 2020 SET is this coming Saturday and we will start at 0900 Local on the linked repeater network. I will also be monitoring the Statewide DMR network. One of the tasks that operators will be asked to do is to pass a status report to MARS. This report can be by voice, email or even better by Winlink. If you have Winlink and can help other pass their messages please do. This is all about getting the messages through. The following rules will apply to this years SET.

1. The two objectives of the SET are to activate local nets and to pass messages.
2. Messages may be sent to or received from FM Voice, HF Voice (CT ARES will not be running an HF net), Winlink, or you may deliver the "Last Mile" messages by email or telephone.
3. All messages in Winlink format can be sent to both K1DFS and W8ZY. Please send to both.
4. Request read receipts on your messages in Winlink.

All information in the SWEAT format is to be factual. **DO NOT MAKE UP MESSAGES WITH FALSE INFO!**

There will be a report generator on the CTARES.Org website but you will have to copy and paste the report.

Practice ahead of time and get your report ready to send on Saturday. The report format has no date or time only the message will have that so you can be prepared. Practice now.

Here is the SWEAT format to use:

- 14) MEDICALSERVICES (NORMAL, or INTERMITTENT, or UNAVAILABLE)
- 15) PUBLICSAFETYSERVICES (NORMAL, or INTERMITTENT, or UNAVAILABLE)
- 16) SAFETYHAZARDS (NONE, or HAZMAT, or BIOLOGICAL, or HUMAN)
- 17) ROADSHIGHWAYS (NORMAL, or CONGESTED, or DESTROYED)
- 18) AIRPORTS (NORMAL, or CONGESTED, or DESTROYED)
- 19) SOURCE (MARS, or AMATEUR, or GOVAGENCY)
- 20) RMKS (X)

ONLY report REAL information - No FAKE NEWS
